In September, our Library switched to a new system! We have a new catalog and many new features. If you haven't already, come in anytime with your old card or ID and we'll hand you a new one. Among the changes, are the ability for you to receive e-mail or text notifications when items are overdue or holds have arrived.

We have many new capabilities with our online catalog, such as changing your contact information, searching by reading levels, and setting up an "EZ Login" to access your account without having to remember your library card

number. You can also place holds and renew checked-out materials. Our Online Services, such as Overdrive and RB Digital, should work the same as normal once you have your new library card set-up. There are lots of online help pages provided on our catalog using the link at the bottom of the page.
